# New York State Specialist Comes Up With Ruppert Variations:

New York State coaster collector Warren Johnsen has been after those 4" coaster varieties from New York breweries for many years. To help us all to understand the many variations of the fairly common Jacob Ruppert Brewery coasters, he has sent in the accompanying 5 photos. Look closely at these photos and try to remember the subtle differences in them when you are at a trade meet. These coasters turn up quite often and all 5 variations are available in the \$2.00 to \$4.00 range.







Stanton Coasters Anybody? Is that coaster a variety or did I just trade away a coaster that I need for my collection!?!?

Chuck King has an eye for coaster variations. In all of the years that I have corresponded with Chuck, he has come up with some unbelievable coasters -- which many of us may never have known existed unless they were pointed out to us.

Coaster # 1 is the oldest - made in Austria with pastel colors red and blue. Note that there is no wording under the word "Brewery."

Coaster # 2 is the most common - shown in the B.C.G. as coaster # 1031. This is dark blue and red and has a beer barrel with "Est. 1817" written on it's side.

Coaster # 3 is the latest find by Chuck King... it has "Since 1817" written out and the barrel is deleted. This coaster is also red and dark blue and should be on your "Variations" list wherever you go scouting for those old coasters!



NEW ENGLAND COASTER GUIDE IS PUBLISHED! George Barone of Cheshire, Conneticut has amassed an excellent collection of coasters from New England breweries which he is beginning to document and catalog. His first publication, "Coasters of New England, Vol. 1 - Conneticut" has 13 pages containing photos of 46 different Conneticut coasters.

George has carefully assigned each coaster a number and has left his identification system "open-ended" so that new finds may be added. He plans to update this loose-leaf format book with photos of new finds in order to keep the guide as complete as possible.

The book comes in a 8-1/2" x 11" notebook which can easilly be updated by removing an old page and replacing it with the new updated page... much like a typical stamp album with it's annual supplement.

After going through my collection of photos of coasters, I found an Aetna and a rare Wehle variety which were not shown in George's booklet.... I'm sure that he'll be including these two and any that YOU send in to him in his update.

George's actions are to be applauded as many of us have thought about doing a book which would show all known coasters from a particular state. I hope that George will continue with Volume 2 - Massachusetts. Obviously, this state is a much bigger under taking and will be a much thicker volume. Please see George's ad in the back of this issue. The book is well worth the \$2.50 cover price and is the first volume of what looks like an excellent reference work.

# Bavarian Pitcher Coaster Variation Reported:

John Horn, an advanced collector of Ohio, Indiana and Kentucky coasters has written to tell me of a new variation of the Bavarian Brewing Co pitcher coaster that was shown in this newsletter several issues ago. This coaster was known to exist in green. John tells me that he has found one that is the same printing but black instead of green.

Bavarian Brewing Company is from Covington, Kentucky and all oth their coasters are considered extremely tough!

Dealer/collector Frank Donchevich #3 of Caldwell, NJ wrote to me to say that he has the green variety of this large, pitcher coaster on his coaster list for \$40. Frank says it's a rather good seller at that price!
